	<p>The opponents and how they are trying to divide us.</p> <p><i>Now put a little "they" against our big "WE": Specifically, name who is responsible for the problem and how strategic racism and fall guys are being used to divide and distract us.</i></p>
	<p>Solution and call to action</p> <p><i>Show how we can solve the problem by acting together. End with a positive vision.</i></p>
